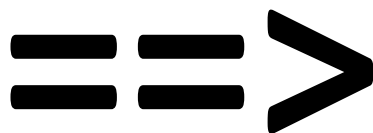

Science and Technology: essential to move towards more sustainable pathways.

Innovation is a broadly inclusive term that can encompass the work of **both formal S&T enterprises,** and **the informal, grassroots ideas and inventions of people** not associated with research institutions



ST&I : a major prerequisite for Sustainable and Equitable Socio-economic Development

-Science, Technology and Innovation : heart of sustainable growth strategy for Europe and Brazil

-**International cooperation** is a key element of ST&I strategy for Europe and Brazil

Under the EU/Brazil S&T Cooperation agreement, the Joint Science and Technology Steering Committee (JSTSC) is the main body to develop a strategic partnership :

- * addressing key societal challenge
- * promoting reciprocity in programmes
- * funding regional cooperation

Main orientations on EU-BR ST&I cooperation

- Use of various mechanisms of networking (joint calls*, twining of projects, programme level cooperation for selection and funding of projects, ...)
- Encouraging partnerships, joint activities, exchange/mobility of researchers
- Brazilian participation in FP7 and Horizon 2020
- European participation in Brazilian programmes
- Enhancing EU-BR dialogue in ST&I and regional cooperation
- Establishing dialogue on civil space cooperation (GEO, ...)
- Promoting cooperation between JRC and Brazilian research centres

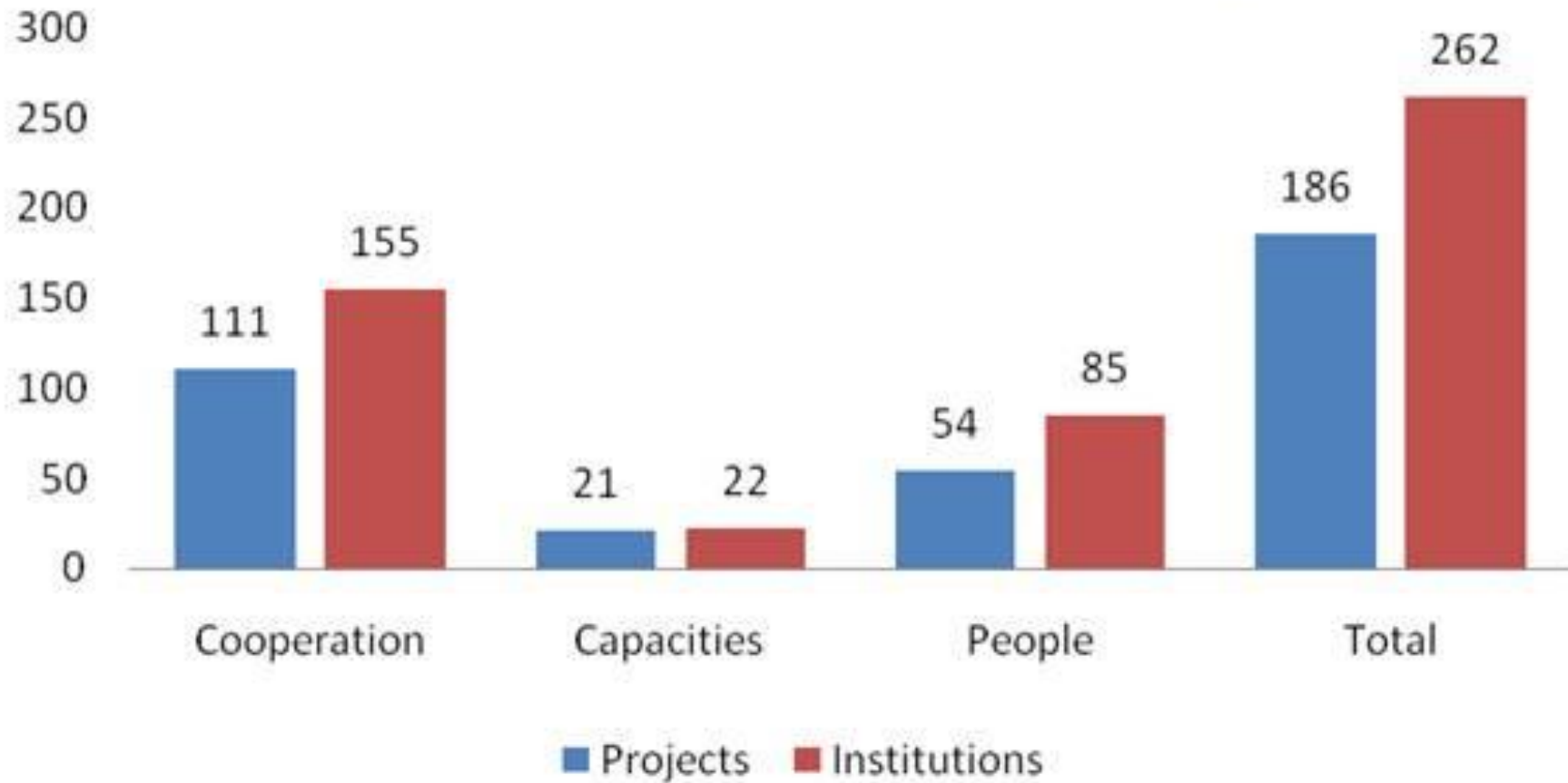
(2005/2011):

- To improve the cooperation in science, technology and innovation between Brazil and the European Union.
- Its mission was to disseminate the services offered in its webpage, implement database with information about the research institutions in Brazil and to make an analytical description about the Brazilian scientific and technological structures in relation to the ten FP7 thematic areas.
- It also included the implementation of other mechanisms to reinforce international cooperation in science, technology and innovation between Brazil and the European Union.

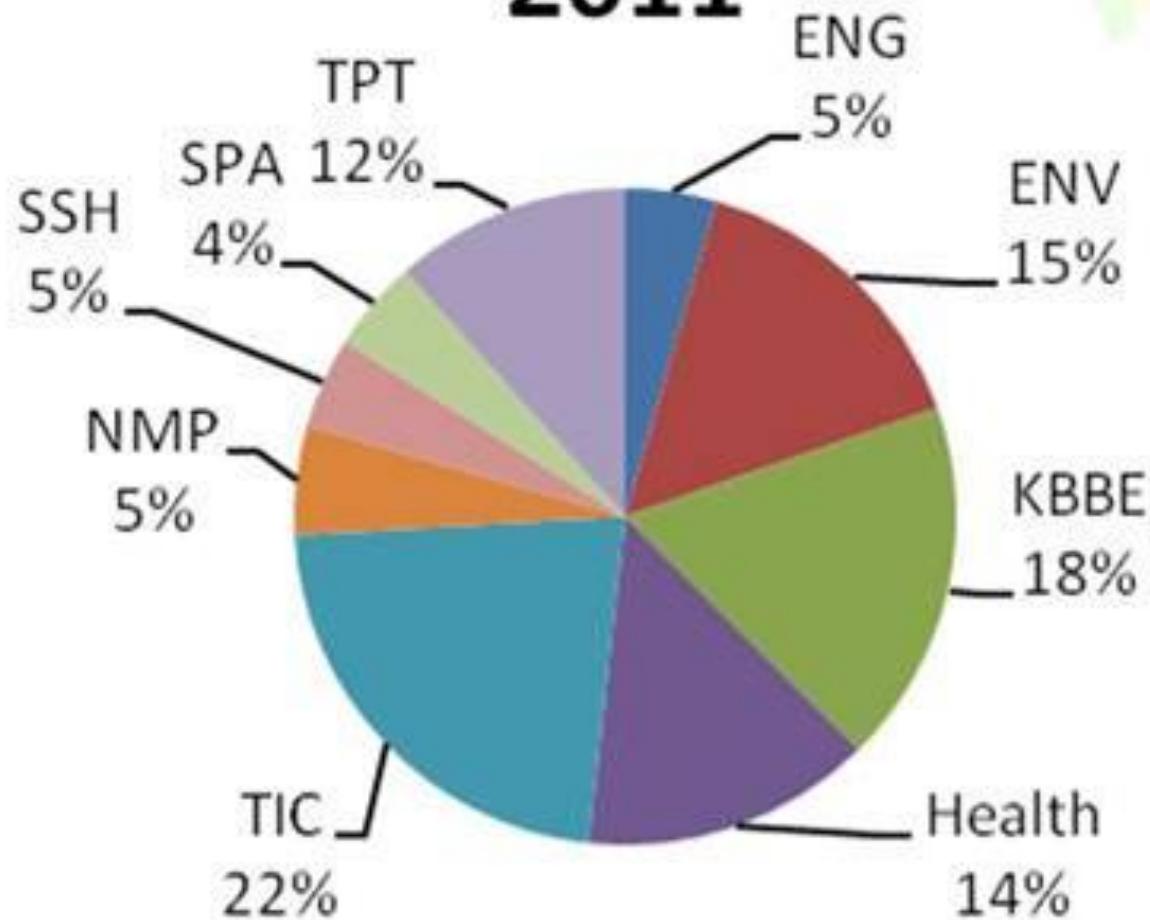

(2009/2012) :

- To enhance the access of European researchers in the national research and innovation programmes of Brazil.
- collection of information regarding the national research and innovation capacities and programmes within Brazil.
- to disseminate this information to the widest possible number of researchers and other stakeholders in the European Research Area.



Something new - but more than the continuity of B.BICE and APORTA – including:

- Support EU/Br ST&I policy dialogue (explicitly);
- Innovation at the heart of B.Bice+ objectives;
- Support coordination on ST&I cooperation between Brazil and EC, EU MS and AC;
- Analyse the results and impacts of the cooperation in ST&I between Brazil and EU.

B.BICE+ main objectives :

- Support political dialogue in ST&I between EU and Brazil;
- Promote sustainable partnerships between EU and Brazilian actors of the whole research-to-innovation chain;
- Contribute to the coordination of EU Members States research policies and programmes, vis-à-vis Brazil on programme level;
- Disseminate information on European and Brazilian programmes that support research and innovation cooperation between EU and Brazil;
- Create an Observatory of the EU-Brazil cooperation on ST&I;
- Promote an approach to innovation as an overarching policy objective for EU-Brazil cooperation.

Orientation of BBICE+ activities on five transversal principles

- 1. Innovation as a cross-cutting dimension***
- 2. The need for coordination between the EU and the Member States***
- 3. Quality feedback and support to the EU-Brazil ST&I policy dialogue***
- 4. Reciprocity***
- 5. Increasing the impact of EU-Brazil ST&I collaboration***

B.Bice+ Principles

- 1. Links between WPs/Tasks and objectives: must be oriented on concrete but sustainable mechanisms.***
- 2. Project initiatives (forum/workshop/seed fund/...): temporary (project duration) versus permanence (institutionalization).***
- 3. B.BICE+ is built on and has to capitalise on prior projects (B.BICE, APORTA, EULARINET, ...) but also on existing best practices (in particular EU MS/AC and Brazil ST&I cooperation).***
- 4. Scoreboard and impact indicators: identification of indicators for tasks and WP (including the target groups).***
- 5. Thematic focus: related to priority fields for the EU-Brazil ST&I cooperation (in a pragmatic way).***

B.BICE+ Work Packages

- 1. WP1 : Information, analysis, dissemination, capacity building, oriented on research cooperation (upstream) + concrete pilot mechanism;***
- 2. WP2: Support to EU MS coordination and pilot coordinated instrument(s) for ST&I cooperation;***
- 3. WP3 : Information, analysis, capacity building, orientated innovation cooperation (downstream) + concrete pilot mechanism;***
- 4. WP4 : Support to policy dialogue;***
- 5. WP5 : Management and communication.***
